FOR THE CONNECTICUT METROPOLITAN REGION, *RECONNECT 1 REGION***

I certify that the following is a true copy of the vote of the Connecticut Metropolitan Council of Governments on December 17th, 2015, Bridgeport, Connecticut, a quorum being present:

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.G.S Section 8-35a every ten years a Regional Council of Governments shall make a Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD) for its area of operation.


WHEREAS, pursuant to C.G.S Section 8-35a the POCD shall identify areas where it is feasible and prudent to have compact, transit accessible, pedestrian-oriented mixed use development patterns and land reuse, shall promote such development patterns and land reuse, shall note any inconsistencies with the State of Connecticut's growth management principles and shall be designed to reduce hypoxia, pathogens, toxic contaminants and floatable debris in Long Island Sound.

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Metropolitan Council of Governments is the Council of Governments for the Connecticut Metropolitan Region and, through a proactive public engagement process, a POCD, *Reconnect 1 Region* was developed pursuant to C.G.S Section 8-35a.

WHEREAS, the Office of Policy and Management reviewed the draft POCD, *Reconnect 1 Region* and determined the draft POCD to be "not inconsistent" with the 2013-2018 Conservation and Development Policies Plan for Connecticut.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CONNECTICUT METROPOLITAN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that *Reconnect 1 Region* is adopted as the Regional Plan of Conservation and Development for the Connecticut Metropolitan Region.
