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**RESOLUTION OF THE
GREATER BRIDGEPORT REGIONAL COUNCIL
CONCERNING
METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
CONSOLIDATION**

Bridgeport, Connecticut

WHEREAS, The State of Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) has identified \$16 billion in unfunded capital needs over the next twenty years, including \$7.5 billion needed over the next decade for system preservation and enhancement;

WHEREAS, the modification of geographical boundaries of Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPO) offers a unique opportunity for the State of Connecticut to establish a strategic framework to address such need;

WHEREAS, the GBRC has determined the State of Connecticut is at a competitive disadvantage on a national level given its fragmented political structure, and lack of systems to support coordinated transportation planning and infrastructure investment;

WHEREAS, recent transportation authorization contained in Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) exacerbates such problems for MPOs as it imposes more responsibilities, requires additional technical capability, and establishes metrics for performance measures and management;

WHEREAS, the GBRC has determined a single statewide MPO to develop statewide transportation policy would best address such issues, and streamline the planning and delivery of federal and state transportation projects;

WHEREAS, such organizational structure would foster the implementation of a statewide Regional Long Range Transportation Plan, and corresponding Transportation Improvement Program (TIP);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Greater Bridgeport Regional Council hereby supports the establishment of a single statewide MPO to coordinate the planning activities of newly structured Regional Councils of Governments.
