

## **Notice of Action:**

The GBVMPO is considering amendment of the Transportation Improvement Program to add the following project:

Project #0138-Hxxx: Route 110 Engineering/Planning Study, Stratford – The planned activity will conduct an engineering assessment of traffic operations and safety along Route 110 from the intersection of Main Street Putney to Warner Hill Road. It will include assessing the need to rehabilitate and modify the roadway and realign the main access driveway at Sikorsky Aircraft with Oronoque Lane. The scope of work includes: data collection (traffic counts, turning movement counts, accidents), survey, assessment and modeling of traffic operations, right of way impacts, estimate of future traffic volume based on economic development scenarios, identification of actions and cost estimates. Public outreach will be conducted throughout the project. (The full project application is attached).

STP: Urban Funding Allocation – The project is funded by 80% federal funds and 20% local funds.

At the June 17th meeting of the GBVMPO, the proposed Route 110 engineering and planning study was presented and discussed. Subsequent to that meeting, the GBRC held several discussions with the Connecticut Department of Transportation and the Town of Stratford. As a result of these discussions, CDOT has approved the use of STP: Urban funds to conduct the planning study and has requested amendment of the TIP to add the project. In accordance with the GBVMPO's bylaws, an electronic vote on the amendment is being conducted. Notice of intent to amend the TIP/STIP and copy of all meeting materials are posted on GBRC website. This action is consistent with the GBVMPO's Public Participation Program Handbook.

### The proposed Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Connecticut Department of Transportation is requesting an amendment to the TIP/STIP to add program funding under the Surface Transportation Program: Bridgeport-Stamford (STP: BS) urban area allocation to conduct an engineering planning study along Route 110 in Stratford;

**WHEREAS**, these amendments represents a minor modification of the TIP/STIP and involves a planning study that is exempt from the regional emissions analyses and does not necessitate a new air quality analysis.

This action is effective as of August 5, 2013.
